1. The item shall be packaged in accordance with the above packaging requirements code and the following:

- a. Product shall be supplied on plastic or fiberboard core.
- b. Widths and lengths of material shall be specified by the procuring activity.
- c. Each packaged roll container and each shipping container shall be labeled with the following:

"LAY FLAT ONLY - DO NOT STAND ON END"

Rolls shall be maintained in a horizontal position at all times during handling, shipping and storage.

d. Marking for each container shall be per MIL-STD-129. One label shall be placed inside the center core and an additional label shall be placed on the outside of each unit container.

e. Each shipping container label shall be identical to the unit label, plus, GROSS and NET weights and number of rolls in container.
