1. The item shall be packaged in accordance with the above packaging requirements code and the following:

a. Separate each tile with brown kraft paper.

b. Tiles with Pressure Sensitive Adhesive (PSA) have a shelf life and shall be marked IAW MIL-STD-129 requirements.

c. Construct each crate with the outside frame made from 2" X 4" lumber and a top and bottom made from 3/8" plywood, both reinforced with 1" X 4" lumber. The runners on the base will be 2" X 4" lumber. The outside edge of the crates shall be colored red (shadowed area below) to distinguish them from Type 14 tiles. See example below:
